A student must earn a total of 24 credits to graduate from Sault Area High School. Besides meeting all course requirements, students must satisfy all student debts and serve all disciplinary requirements. Students must meet all requirements for a diploma prior to the day of graduation in order to participate in the commencement ceremony. Participation in the commencement ceremony is a privilege, not a right.
