LANGUAGE ARTS 4 YEARS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION


- *English 12
- [•]Journalism (yearbook)
- Native American Literature
 - must score a 480 on SAT Reading
 - may be concurrently enrolled in LSSU's English 235
- AP English Literature
 - must score a 480 on SAT Reading
 - may be concurrently enrolled in LSSU's English 110 & 111





4 YEARS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION

- [•] Algebra II or Honors Algebra II
- *SAT Math Prep (S1)/Statistics (S2)
 - if you score under a 530 on SAT Math
- Pre-Calculus
 - if you have a B- or higher in Geometry and Algebra II
- Senior math experience—all CTE classes & some science




SCIENCE 3 YEARS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION

- * Environmental Science
 - [•] if you have completed Biology and Chemistry
- *Anatomy & Physiology
- * Health Science 1 or 2 (senior math credit)
- Natural Resources (2 hours, senior math credit)
- AP Biology
 - * must score a 480 on SAT Reading

- Physics (senior math credit)
 - if you have done well in Honors Chemistry
 - if you are considering studying engineering or medicine in college
- College Chemistry 115 (senior math)
 - must score a 570 on SAT Math



SOCIAL STUDIES 3 YEARS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION



US History, World History, Civics, & Economics REQUIRED
 May take as electives:

AP US History (must score a 480 on SAT Reading)
AP US Government (must score a 480 on SAT Reading)
AP Psychology (must score a 480 on SAT Reading)
AP World History(must score a 480 on SAT Reading)

 - 5 additional core courses




