HOW MANY CLASSES CAN I TAKE? CAN I SKIP TAKING MATH? DON'T I GET TO TAKE "FUN" CLASSES? WHAT IS A CREDIT?

- You will schedule for 7 class periods
- No, you can't skip math. You can't skip English or social studies or science, either
- All of the classes are fun—or they can be. Make the most of your time in high school!
- A credit is a full year of a course.
- Some courses are 1 semester (so they will count as ½ credit)

LANGUAGE ARTS 4 YEARS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION

English 9

or

Honors English 9
 must have good grades in English 8, be
 recommended by your teacher, and have a score
 of 410 or higher on the PSAT Reading test

MATHEMATICS 4 YEARS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION

Algebra I

or

- Honors Geometry
 if you have Algebra 1 now and a score of 450 or higher on the PSAT Math test
 or
- AMPED (Algebra 1 + Drafting)

or

- GIC (Geometry + Construction)
 - if you have Algebra 1 now and a score of 450 or higher on the PSAT Math test (2-hour blocks!)

SCIENCE 3 YEARS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION

- Physical Science if you struggle in science (C- or lower)
- Biology

If you are unsure, please talk to your science teacher

WORLD LANGUAGES 1-2 YEARS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION

- Spanish 1
- French 1

(you may substitute a CTE program or a fine art for a 2nd year of language)

*Keep in mind that the number of spots in the world language classes are limited and you might not get your language class your freshman year

COMPUTER SCIENCE & PHYSICAL EDUCATION 1 SEMESTER OF EACH REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION

• Physical Education (1 semester or full year)

•Weight Training (1 semester or full year)

Computer Science (1 semester)

SOCIAL STUDIES 3 YEARS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION

•Modern US History required for all freshmen
