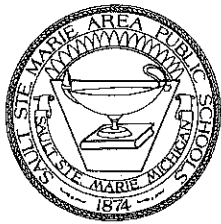

For the 2018-19 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given. Our school was identified as "not been given one of these labels".

Sault Area Middle School has implemented many educational strategies aimed at closing the achievement gap between our highest and lowest achieving students. Some of these strategies are: Leveled Literacy Intervention, Math180, Achieve 3000, MAST, SAIL and NWEA Map testing. It is our goal to close the achievement gap between our highest and lowest performing students while continuing to elevate the performance level of all of our students.

Sault Area Middle School has been serving the Sault Ste. Marie community since 1916. The school's attendance area has been established by the Sault Area Public Schools district, Sault Area Public Schools has adopted the national core curriculum.
