



Slavery in the Americas


More than 11 million Africans were sold into slavery in the Americas. Most were put to work on plantations in the West Indies and Brazil.

- ★ In North America, the Southern Colonies copied the plantation system, which relied on slave labor.
- ★ By 1760 enslaved people were held in all 13 colonies, but slavery remained concentrated on plantations and in large cities.
- ★ Although far outnumbered by enslaved people, many people of African descent gained their freedom and continued to live in the colonies.
