After school programs play a major role in providing meaningful science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) learning experiences to diverse groups of youth. Afterschool programs can support students' success in STEM in a multitude of ways—by helping them become interested and engaged, develop tangible STEM skills, and begin to see themselves as potential contributors to the STEM enterprise. Developmentally appropriate lessons are established everyday for students. The lessons follow a scope and sequence that builds new skills each week. Consistent attendance is required. Washington Students will be bussed to Lincoln when school is dismissed.
