Hello Blue Devils families and staff.

We have been made aware of positive COVID-19 cases at Sault Middle School. The affected individuals are under quarantine. The Chippewa County Health Department (CCHD) is investigating the cases and conducting contact tracing to determine close contacts. Those identified as close contacts will be contacted directly by the Chippewa County Health Department and receive instructions on what to do next.

It is clear that COVID is still a concern in our community we encourage everyone to please remember to practice the 3 Ws. These practices are very important if we want to keep our kids in school!!

Wear a mask covering your nose and mouth

Watch your distance

Wash your hands with soap and water frequently for at least 20 seconds

In accordance with HIPAA and FERPA laws, health information is private and we will not provide specifics about the cases.

We ask that all students and staff fully cooperate with CCHD which will prevent further spread of the disease in our community. If you are contacted by the CCHD and placed under quarantine or isolation for a COVID-19 infection, please let the district know.
